Dear Councillors & Burwell Parish Council,

Cambridgeshire County Council proposes to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police the effect of which will be to :-

Implement a 40mph speed limit in Burwell on the following roads;

- Ness Road (B1102): from a point 132 metres northeast of its junction with Toyse Lane in a north easterly direction for a distance of 400 metres.
- Newmarket Road (B1103): from a point 38 metres southeast of its junction with Barkways in a south easterly direction for a distance 261 metres.
- Swaffham Road (B1102): From a point 552 metres southwest of its junction with Heath Road in a south westerly direction for a distance of 400 metres.

The proposed 40mph buffer limits are intended to reduce the speed of traffic entering/leaving the village and result in a smoother transition between the national speed limit and the 30mph limit in the village. These speed limit changes are being proposed following the successful submission of a Local Highway Improvement Initiative (LHI) application from Burwell Parish Council.

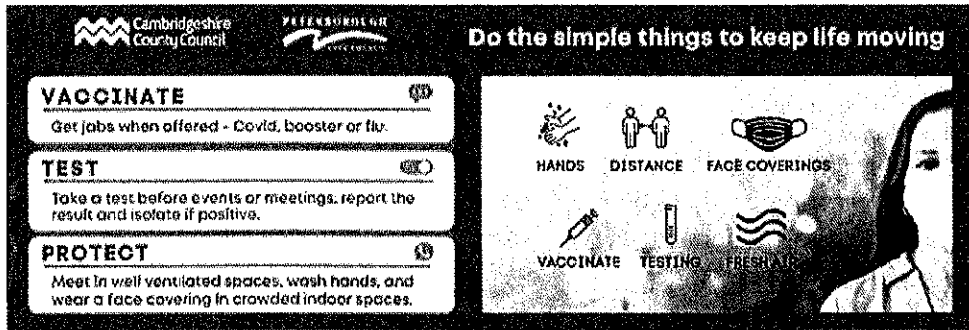

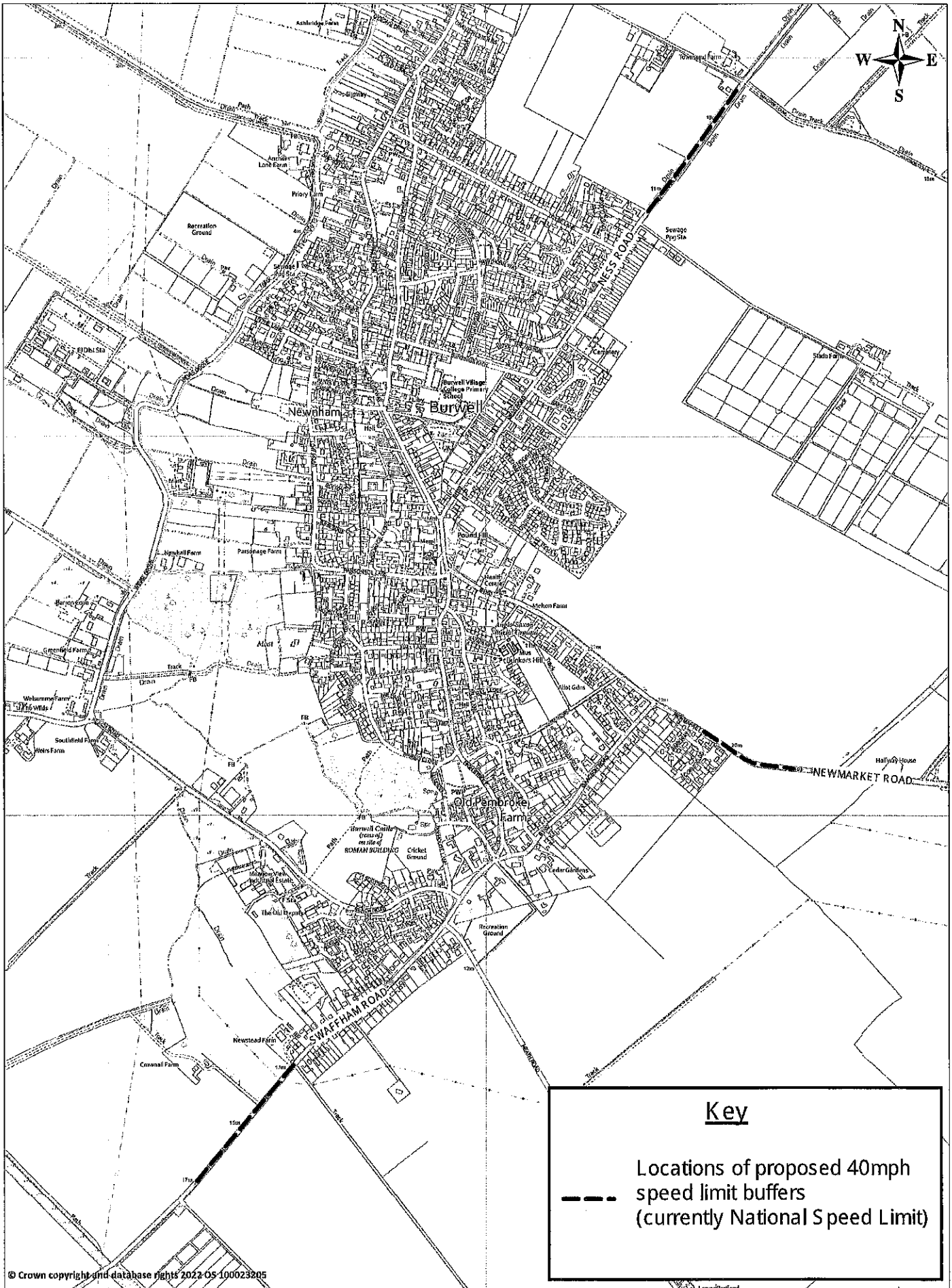
Implement a 40mph speed limit in Burwell on the following roads;
