

Burwell and Fordham

Active Travel Survey



What are we doing?

Funding has been made available to produce preliminary designs for an active travel route between Burwell and Fordham.

We are carrying out a survey to understand local residents' views on active travel improvements between the two villages and within Burwell and Fordham themselves. We would like to know how you are currently travelling, how you would like to travel, and whether any improvements could support increased walking, wheeling and cycling journeys.

What is active travel?

Active travel refers to walking, wheeling and cycling. Including the use of mobility aids such as wheelchairs and pushchairs as well as scooters and adapted cycles.

Is there a preferred linking route?

We have reviewed the East Cambs District Council feasibility study, which provides six active travel route options between Burwell and Fordham. After careful consideration, we have a preferred route that links Burwell and Fordham via Exning using Burwell Road and Cotton End Road/Landwade Road, but we would welcome your views.

What's next?

The survey responses will indicate whether there is local support for active travel interventions between Burwell and Fordham and within the villages themselves. This will enable us to consider some feasibility work and potential further engagement on the routes.
